DIRECTIONS FOR USE

PRIOR TO SOWING OR PLANTING: apply 140 grammes per square metre (4oz per square yard).

ESTABLISHED ROSES, SHRUBS AND BORDER PLANTS: apply as a top dressing in the Spring at 140 grammes per square metre (4oz per square yard).

FRUIT TREES AND BUSHES: apply as a top dressing in the Autumn at 140 grammes per square metre (4oz per square yard).
